**Notice for Round 2 counseling for UG Medical, Dental and AYUSH State Quota, Management Quota, NRI Quota and AYUSH central quota (private college) seats in West Bengal 2020**

The following candidates are eligible for Round 2 counseling WB UG 2020 with required activities in Round 2 counseling WB UG 2020 :-

- A. The eligible and qualified candidates through NEET UG 2020, who **failed to enroll in Round 1** counseling, can apply for **fresh enrollment and payment of counseling fee online and have to register online as per schedule.**
- B. The candidates, who **enrolled earlier but failed to pay the counseling fees in Round 1**, can directly **pay such fee online and then they have to register online as per schedule.**
- C. The candidates, who **enrolled and paid fee in Round 1 but failed to register in Round 1**, can, **register afresh online as per schedule.**
- D. The candidates **who made non malafide error in filling up enrollment details in Round 1** but have not filled choice in Round 1 and **have applied online for re-enrollment**, they can apply for **fresh enrollment and payment of counseling fee online and have to register online as per schedule (once the request for re-enrollment is approved from WBMCC).**
- E. The candidates who have successfully enrolled, paid fee, registered and filled choice online in Round 1 but **remained non allotted in Round 1** at their rank.
- F. The candidates who have successfully enrolled, paid fee, registered and filled choice online in Round 1, were **allotted and admitted in a college in Round 1 and expressed willingness for participation in Round 2** counseling.
- G. The candidates who have successfully enrolled, paid fee, registered and filled choice online in Round 1, were **allotted but failed in document verification and the seats were cancelled but remained eligible for Round 2 and subsequent round/s as per changed criteria of eligibility.**

Above type of candidates **A to G**, after necessary activities as detailed above as applicable, **have to fill fresh choice in Round 2 as per schedule** in order to be considered for allotment as per inter se merit. **Provisional list of candidates for Round 2** who have successfully enrolled and paid counseling fee online, shall be published in counseling website as per schedule.

Above type of candidates **A to G**, **should not belong to** the sub set of candidates who **appear in the finally admitted candidate list** in Round 2 for All India Counseling UG 2020 including Deemed University and Central University or Apex Institutes counseling conducted by All India Authority UG 2020, as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order.

The **earlier listed candidates for Round 1** shall automatically appear in the Provisional list of Round 2 as per their **New State Serial Number** (after incorporation of the candidates type **A to G** as stated earlier as applicable) **provided such candidates do not fall under below mentioned groups:-**

1. Registered candidate, who filled up choice in Round 1, got allotted in Round 1 but **not reported** for admission and thus he/she got out of the counseling process.
2. Registered candidate, who filled up choice in Round 1, got allotted in Round 1, reported for admission but was **cancelled** due to insufficient document in Round 1 and remains non eligible for Round 2 or later round/s with changed criteria during admission process of Round 1
3. Registered candidate, who filled up choice in Round 1, got allotted in Round 1; reported for admission and later **surrendered** his/her seat online as he/she is not satisfied with such seat and thus got out of the counseling process.
4. Registered candidate, who filled up choice in Round 1, got allotted in Round 1, reported for admission and showed that he/she was **unwilling** for participation in Round 2 during the process of reporting for admission.
5. Candidates who **appear in the finally admitted candidate list** in Round 2 for All India Counseling UG 2020 including Deemed University and Central University or Apex Institutes counseling conducted by All India Authority UG 2020, as per Hon'ble Supreme Court order.

The counseling committee shall wait for the completion of the Round 2 of the All India Quota admission process UG 2020 to be over and after transfer of the vacant seats of West Bengal All India Quota to the State Quota; the Seat Matrix of Round 2 shall be published.

Such seat matrix shall include non allotted seats of Round 1, non reported seats of Round 1, surrendered or cancelled seats of Round 1 (if any) , All India Quota transferred seats of Round 2 and any new seats added afresh after MCI/DCI/AYUSH approval (if any). The All India Quota seats after transfer to State Quota shall be re-rostered as per State policy of reservation. If any new seats are added after approval of MCI/DCI/AYUSH such seats shall also be rostered as per State policy of reservation.

The All India authority shall also hand over the list of the candidates who remain finally admitted in the Round 2 of the All India quota counseling and admission process of 2020. Such candidates shall not be eligible to take part in any counseling as per order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

**So the names of such candidates shall be excluded ( provided such list is been made available by the All India Authority to the WBMCC) before preparation of Provisional list for Round 2 who have successfully enrolled and paid counseling fees online for WB UG 2020 counseling.**

**It is well understood that the State Serial Number for an individual candidate as appears in the List for Round 2 may differ from the previous List for Round 1 for obvious reasons.**

Already registered and eligible candidates for Round 2 and newly eligible & newly registered candidates of round 2 can **fill choice afresh for Round 2** for participation in Round 2 counseling. If registered and eligible candidate for Round 2 does not fill choice for round 2, then he/she cannot be considered for allotment in Round 2. **The earlier choices put forth by candidates in Round 1 shall be null and void.**

After fresh choice filling and saving and locking of choices in Round 2 within stipulated time, the system shall process the locked choices for allotment. If the candidate fails to lock the saved choices, then system shall auto-lock such choices after the choice locking period is over. **The choices once locked**

cannot be changed (no scope for further rectification in this regard). Only the locked choices shall be processed for allotment by the system.

The following situations that can happen are detailed below:-

- a. If an eligible candidate, who is a seat holder in Round 1, does not fill choice afresh in Round 2, then his/her seat in Round 1 shall remain intact.
- b. If an eligible candidate, who is a seat holder in Round 1, fills choice afresh and he/she is **allotted** in Round 2, then the **earlier seat in Round 1 gets automatically cancelled** and the candidate has to **obtain online release letter** from the previously admitted institute and then has to get admitted in newly allotted institute in Round 2 within stipulated time by **personal physical appearance** by deposition of original required documents, fee and bond as per extant rule for securing admission in the WB UG counseling 2020 after necessary verification of the documents. **If such candidate fails to do so within stipulated time or fails in document verification, then his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.**
- c. If an eligible candidate, who is a seat holder in Round 1, fills choice afresh but he/she is not allotted in Round 2 as per his/her choice depending on his/her rank position in Round 2 eligible list, then the seat occupied by the candidate in earlier round shall remain intact.
- d. If an eligible candidate, who is not a seat holder in Round 1, fills choice afresh and **allotted** in Round 2, then such candidate has to get admitted in the allotted college by **personal physical appearance** by deposition of original required documents, fee and bond as per extant rule for securing admission in the WB UG counseling 2020 after necessary verification of the documents. **If such candidate fails to do so within stipulated time or fails in document verification, then his/her candidature shall stand cancelled.**

The candidates who are allotted in Round 2 shall have the option of exercising willingness for centralized manual Mop Up (if seats still remain vacant after round 2 admissions) while reporting at the allotted institute within stipulated time. If they opt for such Mop Up then they can participate in centralized manual Mop Up if they wish. If they do not opt for such Mop Up then they are barred from participation in centralized manual Mop Up and the counseling for them ends for 2020.

The details for eligibility, criteria, schedule of centralized manual Mop Up round (if any) shall be informed later on in the website [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) and candidates are requested to visit such website from time to time since no personal communication is possible.

**The last date for admission in Round 2 shall also be the last date for seat surrender without penalty for candidates who are admitted in Round 1 or Round 2 of the WB UG counseling 2020 and any candidate surrendering seat after such date have to do so with the required bond penalty amount.**

If any candidate is upgraded from one Govt. of WB Medical/Dental College to another such in West Bengal then he/she may not have to pay afresh in new allotment. Only producing the receipt of the previous admission would suffice. Needless to say that he/she does not get refund from the releasing institute for obvious reasons.

If any candidate is upgraded from one Non Govt. college to Govt. College or vice versa or from Non Govt. college to another non Govt. college in West Bengal, then the admission fee shall be forfeited and

the candidate shall get back the rest of the fee from releasing college and have to deposit fee afresh as per rule in the newly allotted college for admission.

**The candidates have to submit the requisite bond (discontinuation bond) to the admitting institute within the stipulated time to secure such admission.**

**The tentative updated schedule for counseling in WB UG Round 2 for 2020 is already uploaded in the counseling website.**

**Seat conversion rules:-**

The PwD seats shall be converted to respective categories if such eligible candidate is not found in the allotment process of Round 2.

During the centralized manual Mop Up counselling (the detailed notice and schedule shall be provided later on) the SC seats shall be converted to ST or vice versa; the OBC A seats shall be converted to OBC B seats and vice versa; the EWS seats shall be converted to UR seats.

The NRI seats shall be converted to Management Quota seats if such eligible candidate is not found during college level Mop Up allotment.

**Admission related issues:-**

If college authority is satisfied with the credentials of the candidate then admission shall be granted via NIC portal shared with colleges and the said admission slip generated online shall be shared with the candidate physically.

After submitting the original documents to the colleges the candidate gets a slip stating the essential documents that are submitted to the college.

The candidate gets back such documents after showing such original slip only in up gradation during Mop up counseling/end of the course tenure/resignation after clearing necessary dues with the college authority.

During admission candidate has to state willingness for subsequent round (centralized manual Mop Up) if any. If candidate does not provide willingness for such Mop Up during admission, then he/she cannot participate in centralized manual Mop up round and the WB UG counseling for him/her is over in 2020.

If an allotted candidate in Round 2 does not report physically to allotted college within stipulated time with the requisite original documents, fee and bond then the candidate remains **non-reported and so he/she is out of the counseling process.**

If an admitted candidate of round 1 or 2 surrenders the seat, then also such candidate cannot participate in the counseling process any further. **He/she however can surrender seat without penalty till the completion of the admission process of Round 2 WB UG 2020.**

**The list of the original documents that are required in verification and admission process to be submitted are already in place in the counseling website for reference to the concerned candidates.**

If SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidate is allotted in UR seat and not produce valid certificate, then the caste status shall be edited to UR for counselling purpose by the allotted institute and the admission letter shall be generated for this round and database will be updated and the candidate shall be considered in centralized manual Mop up as UR only.

If SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidate is allotted in respective caste/quota seat and not produce valid certificate, then caste status shall be edited to UR for counselling purpose by the allotted institute and then cancellation order of seat for this round shall be generated and database will be updated and candidate shall be considered as UR in centralized manual Mop up only if the said candidate has obtained UR percentile.

If PC (Physically Challenged) candidate is allotted in UR seat and not produce valid certificate, then the PC status shall be changed to non PC and admission letter shall be generated and database will be updated and the candidate shall be considered in centralized manual Mop up as Non PC only.

If PC candidate is allotted a PC seat and not produce valid certificate, then PC status shall be changed to non PC and cancellation order of such allotted seat for this round shall be generated and database will be updated and candidate shall be considered as Non PC in centralized manual Mop up only if the said candidate has obtained the required percentile for counselling even with such changed status.

**Although the admission process in Round 2 specifies the requirement of the physical presence of candidate with all required credentials and fee and bond at the allotted college, the final situation shall depend upon the COVID-19 condition prevailing at that time and related administrative issues. Candidates are advised to visit the website [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in) for regular updates.**

**If any candidate is found to have submitted incomplete document/fake/false/fabricated certificate or document during admission or later stage of course, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately.**

**The NRI candidates who get fresh allotment in Round 2, have to appear physically with all required essential original documents on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2020 centrally at 4<sup>th</sup> Floor of Swasthya Bhavan GN-29, Sector V, Salt Lake Kolkata 700091 in Office of Joint Director of Medical Education for necessary verification. The document details are as per notice/s published already in counselling website [www.wbmcc.nic.in](http://www.wbmcc.nic.in). Only after necessary verification, such candidates can report to the allotted college for admission.**
