**Urgent notice for college round Medical Dental WB UG 2020 seat conversion
and participation of candidates as per court order**

As the new registration for college round WB UG 2020 Medical and Dental to be completed at 6 pm of 6th January 2021, NRI candidates if any registered for college mop up are hereby instructed to attend office of Joint Director Medical Education at Swasthya Bhavan Salt Lake Kolkata 700091 between 11 am till 3 pm on 7th January 2021 for required document verification.

After successful document verification they shall state the college of their choice and the same shall be communicated to the said college. They have to report to the said college by 4 pm of 8th January 2021 with required documents and fee and bond else such seat shall be converted to management quota seats at 6 pm of 8th January 2021 and such seats shall be available for counseling from 9th January 2021 as management quota seats. The fee and rules of management quota allotment shall prevail.

In view of the communication received from the Six (6) Private Medical Colleges in West Bengal, the rest of the NRI quota vacant seats shall be converted to the management quota seats for college round at 6 pm of 8th January 2021. Such seats shall be available for counseling from 9th January 2021 as management quota seats. The fee and rules of management quota allotment shall prevail.

If no eligible NRI candidate reports to Swasthya Bhavan on 7th January 2021 by 3 pm or they fail during document verification, then the entire NRI quota vacant seats shall be converted to management quota seats at 6 pm of 7th January 2021 and such seats shall be available for counseling from 8th January 2021 as management quota seats. The fee and rules of management quota allotment shall prevail.

The petitioners allowed as per Hon'ble Court order for Mop Up may appear as per NEET UG 2020 rank with the required order of the Hon'ble High Court in Calcutta. Such order shall not create any equity for them except to appear for mop up as per rank with requisite fee, documents and bond for the college where vacancy exists in college mop up. If such allotment cum admission occurs as per NEET UG 2020 rank, it shall be provided offline by the concerned college and the information to be communicated to WBMCC and NIC to declare such seat as non vacant.
