Notice regarding WB PG Medical 2021 mop up counseling

All India Quota (AIQ) counselling authority has published notice no U-12021/06/2021-MEC dated 16.03.2022 stating that candidate who are remaining admitted in State Quota counselling upto round 2 cannot resign i.e. they cannot participate in any further rounds of counseling.

Candidates who are allotted in All India Quota (AIQ) mop up are not allowed to attend State Quota mop up.


In view of revised cut off provided by NBEMS dated 12.03.2022, candidates who are newly made eligible due to revision of cut off are allowed for mop up counseling. They can enroll, pay counseling fee, register and fill up choice in WB PG Medical 2021 mop up counseling.

In service candidates not having 3 years Rural/Remote/Difficult area service experience shall not enroll or register or participate in mop up in service quota else departmental proceedings shall be done.

If any candidate is found to block seat deliberately then candidature shall be cancelled.

All Colleges to strictly verify original credentials of the allotted candidates.

It is reminded that during registration in West Bengal University of Health Sciences, documents verification may be done again and if candidate is found to have submitted false/fabricated/forged documents, shall not be registered with West Bengal University of Health Sciences and candidature shall be cancelled.
