Notice for WB PG 2022 Round 1 Admission Regarding

Provisional allotment result for WB PG Medical and Dental Round 1 2022 is published. The individual allotment letters are available for download for the successful candidates from the counseling website till closure of updated schedule of round 1 admission. The allotted candidates are required to attend the allotted college within round 1 admission schedule i.e. between 10 am till 6 pm on the schedule dates as per server time, if they wish to get admitted, along with all required original documents with one set self attested photocopy.

The following documents are required for admission as listed below:

- 1. Server generated provisional allotment letter for round 1 WB PG 2022
- 2. Admit card and rank card of NEET PG 2022 / NEET MDS 2022 (as applicable)
- 3. Age proof
- 4. Any two of the three ID cards (Voter Card / Aadhar Card / Passport) of the candidate
- 5. Domicile certificate as applicable for State Quota (in case of Domicile B certificate any two of three ID cards i.e Voter Card / Aadhar Card / Passport of the parent on whom the Domicile B certificate is issued)
- 6. Final MBBS /BDS certificate as applicable (provisional if passed in 2021/22)
- 7. Final MBBS /BDS mark sheet
- 8. Permanent registration certificate e issued from Medical / Dental Council of West Bengal or India as applicable.
- 9. Caste certificate (issued by appropriate authority in West Bengal) (caste certificate issued by authority outside west Bengal shall be treated as unreserved except for central institute)
- 10. Non creamy layer certificate issued on or after 01.04.2021 for OBC candidates whose OBC certificate was issued before 01.04.2021 (from appropriate authority)
- 11. EWS Certificate issued by the appropriate authority on or after 01.04.2021 (as applicable) (not for in-service candidates)
- 12. PwD certificate issued from IPGMER Kolkata Medical Board as applicable.

- 13. Internship certificate.
 - 14. Proof of previous degree or diploma (if applicable)
 - 15. Proof of completion of bond formalities if applicable.
 - 16. For other service candidates in West Bengal except of Dept. of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal, ID card of present employment, NOC form present employer.
 - 17. Acknowledgment receipt generated from counseling website.
 - 18. Successful document verification slip issued by appropriate authority in WB PG counseling 2022.
 - 19. Declaration of health service candidate of Dept. of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal, as per notice dated 21.09.2022 in counseling website.
 - 20. Certificate from institute in charge or custodian of service book regarding rural / remote / difficult are service for in-service candidates of Dept. of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal for PG Medical / Dental (applicable for PG Medical and Dental seats but for DNB sponsored seats rural / remote / difficult area service for three years is not kept mandatory.
 - 21. Posting order and joining report for claiming in service seats under Dept. of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal.
 - 22. For NRI candidates relevant documents like affidavit of the person who is NRI, and the sponsor; Document claiming that document of NRI; Relationship of NRI sponsor with the candidate as per order Hon'ble Supreme Court of India; affidavit that sponsor will provide entire course fee of the candidate: Embassy certificate of the sponsor.
 - 23. Undertaking of all the candidates that he or she is not presently admitted anywhere through AIQ /SQ or DNB counseling held in 2022 or earlier.

The candidates have to provide original document and submit one set self attested photocopy in the allotted college. Out of the above stated original documents the college authority shall mandatorily deposit MBBS /BDS certificate; MBBS/BDS final year mark sheet and MBBS/BDS council registration certificate as stated above along with other relevant certificate and undertaking as stated above. The caste certificate and ID cards shall not be kept by the admitting institute.

The college authority has to be paid the requisite fee for admission by the candidate in appropriate payment method as applicable. The college authority shall also ensure submission on requisite bond by the candidate during admission. The following bonds are relevant for admission:

- 1. Rs.2 Lakhs bond for both open / in service candidate for PG diploma seats as discontinuation bond in Govt. colleges in West Bengal.
- Rs. 5 Lakhs bond for PG MD/MS/MDS Degree seats in Govt. of West Bengal colleges by both open /in service candidates as discontinuation bond.
- 3. There is no discontinuation bond for DNB sponsored seats for in-service candidate (for 3 years degree / 2 year diploma)
- 4. The open candidates shall have to provide indemnity bond to concerned Govt. college of West Bengal to the effect that for diploma course for 2 year they will serve for 2 years after completion of course as per extant rule else they will pay penalty of Rs.10 Lakhs per years of not providing service to Govt. So total bond is Rs. 20 Lakhs. Similarly open candidates getting admitting in 3 years MD/MS course in Govt. of West Bengal colleges shall have to provide indemnity bond to the effect that they will serve three year after completion of course else they will pay Rs. 10 Lakhs per year not providing service to the Govt. So total bond is Rs. 30 Lakhs.
- The in-service candidates of Dept. of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of West Bengal, have to provide indemnity bond at the respective branch of Dept. that is stated in the extant trainee reserve rule (Medical / Dental).

Candidates who are getting admission in private colleges / trust colleges / central institutes have to submit the bond / bank guaranty as per requirement of the said college (preference to be given to candidate's choice for providing bond / bank guaranty). Submission of documents, requisite fee and bond is mandatory for admission. If due to present festive situation where candidate is unable to submit bond (notarized in non judicial stamp paper with demy paper as required of not less than Rs. 100) then an undertaking may be accepted by the admitting college that candidate will provide such bond within 15 days from the day of admission, else the seat shall be considered as vacated and shall go to the subsequent round of counseling as available in the counseling schedule.

It may so happen that a candidate applying for SC /ST /OBC/OBC A/OBC B/EWS category may be allotted unreserved seat if he or she has secured the unreserved cutoff in NEET PG / NEET MDS 2022 examination. If the candidate fails to produce caste certificate (as appropriate) the admission shall still be granted and candidature shall be edited to unreserved so that in subsequent round (round 2) candidate may appear for up gradation as unreserved only if he / she wishes for.

If SC /ST /OBC/OBC A/OBC B/EWS candidate is allotted to the respective caste seat and cannot produce valid appropriate certificate then the candidature shall be edited to unreserved and cancellation of seat for this round through admission software shall be done by the concerned college authority. If the candidate have obtained unreserved cut-off, then he / she shall be able to participate for subsequent round for unreserved. If it is found that the said candidate has not obtained the unreserved cut-off then he or she shall be out of counseling process.



"Similar to above, if a PwD (Person with disability) candidate is allotted non PwD seat due to his eligibility and cannot provide the PwD certificate from IPGMER Kolkata Medical board, then the said candidate shall be granted admission but candidature shall be edited to the non PwD status by the concerned college in counseling admission software so that candidate can be eligible for up gradation in round 2 as a non PwD candidate if he or she wishes for.

If PwD candidate is allotted to the respective PwD seat and cannot produce valid appropriate certificate then the candidature shall be edited to non PwD status and cancellation of seat for this round through admission software shall be done by the concerned college authority. If the candidate is otherwise eligible as non PwD candidate, then he / she shall be able to participate for subsequent round as non PwD candidate. If it is found that the said candidate has not obtained the requisite cutoff as non PwD candidate then he or she shall be out of counseling process.

All the admission must be secured through the NIC (National Informatics Centre) server provided to the admitting colleges by the counseling committee mandatorily within the schedule time frame of admission. Candidate must also ensure obtaining one copy of server generated admission / cancellation letter as applicable. Otherwise their admission shall not be considered and the said seat comes to subsequent round as vacant seat.

If a candidate is not satisfied with the seat after admission, they may physically appear before the college authority personally for seat surrender / resignation and such slip shall also be generated through the NIC server by the concerned college else such seat shall not appear in the subsequent round as vacant seat.

The admission desk / kiosk of the following private medical and dental colleges are arranged in the premises of Calcutta National Medical College Kolkata for round 1 : KPC Medical College ; IQ City Medical College ; ICARE Haldia ; Gouri Devi Institute of Medical Science ; JIMS Budge Budge and Gurunanak Dental College ; Haldia Dental College.
