Tentative Schedule for WB PG Medical Counseling 2024 Special Stray Vacancy Round

- In pursuance to the notice published by MCC, New Delhi dated 05.03.2025 bearing ref. U-12021/04/2024-MEC (copy attached as annexure), a Special Stray Vacancy Round will be conducted as per schedule provided below.
- The candidates who are not holding /joined any seat in the previous rounds of NEET PG Counseling 2024 or WB NEET PG Counseling 2024 are eligible to participate in this round of counseling. The candidates having a percentile of score of 5 percentile and above for all categories are eligible in this round of counseling.
- Candidates already allotted and joined a seat in AIQ/ WB State Counseling are not eligible to participate in this round of counseling. Candidates who had been allotted seats by MCC/ WBMCC in Round 3 and Stray Vacancy round but did not join the allotted seats are also not allowed to participate in this round of counseling.
- It is very much pertinent to mention that allotted candidates in this round of counseling who will not join, will be debarred from NEET PG 2025.
- The allotted candidates in AIQ Special Stray Vacancy Round are also not eligible for this round of Counseling.



NOTICE

Kind Attention:

PG Counselling 2024 candidates are informed as under:

All the NEET PG eligible candidates informed that some seats are still lying vacant due to Non-Joining/ Non-Reporting after the completion of Stray Vacancy Round of PG counselling 2024. The details of the vacant seats are available on MCC website (www.mcc.nic.in).

In view of above, the competent authority has decided to reduce the percentile further and has made eligible candidates having percentile score of **5% and above (for all categories)** and to conduct a **Special Stray Vacancy Round** for the vacant seats in an online mode so that the precious medical seats do not go waste.

The rule position for Special Stray Vacancy Round is as under:

- Fresh Registration will take place in Special Stray Vacancy Round. Candidates will have to do Fresh Choice Filling for Special Stray Vacancy Round.
- All AIQ Registered candidates irrespective of their category are required to pay a Refundable Security Deposit of Rs. 50,000 for participation in Special Stray Vacancy Round for exercising choices for Govt. seats.
- Candidates registered for Deemed Universities will have to pay the Refundable Security Deposit of Rs. 3,00,000 to exercise choices for Deemed University.
- **Refundable Security Deposit of candidates who do not join the seats allotted to them in Special Stray Vacancy Round will be Forfeited and they will not be eligible to take NEET PG exam for next year i.e NEET -2025.**

- Candidates who will be allotted seats in Special Stray Vacancy Round will have to report at the allotted Institute and join the seat with their original documents within stipulated time mentioned in the schedule.
- The list of candidates who have been allotted seats in AIQ Special Stray Vacancy Round will be shared with state counselling authorities and such candidates will be debarred from taking admission in Special Stray Vacancy Round of state counselling.
- Candidates participating in Special Stray Vacancy Round will have to furnish an undertaking with respect to allotment of seats at the time of Choice Filling on MCC portal as under:

“I agree to participate in the Special Stray Vacancy Round of NEET-PG Counselling, 2024. I affirm that I fulfill the eligibility criteria as mentioned in the notice dated 05.03.2025 for Special Stray Vacancy Round of NEET PG 2024.

I understand that these seats are precious in nature. Hence, if I am allotted a seat during the Special Stray Vacancy Round, I will join the allotted seat. If, due to any reason I do not join the allotted seat my refundable security deposit will be forfeited along with debarment from NEET PG 2025 and any action including legal may be taken by the Competent Authority.”

The Eligibility of candidates to participate in Special Stray Vacancy Round is reiterated as under:

• ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE:

- a. Candidates who are ‘Not Holding/joined’ any seat in the previous rounds of NEET-PG Counselling, 2024 of All India Quota/State Quota/ Deemed University.
- b. Candidates having a percentile score of 5% and above (for all categories)

INELIGIBLE CANDIDATE:

- a. A candidate already allotted & joined a seat in AIQ/State Counselling/ Deemed University.
- b. A candidate who had been allotted a seat by MCC in AIQ Round-3 & Stray Vacancy Round earlier but did not join the allotted seat.
